YOUR SHIP

Quark's newest ship, Ultramarine, is designed to go beyond the familiar and immerse you in the best the region has to offer. Its four zodiac embarkation points and sea-level Zodiac platforms make for efficient loading off the ship and opportunities for spontaneous off-ship adventures. Day 1, Sunday 14th June ARRIVE HELSINKI

Your Arctic adventure begins in Helsinki. We'll be staying near the airport, and a representative from Quark will be available at the hotel to answer any questions before we board tomorrow. Tonight's hotel is included, but meals and sightseeing in Helsinki are at your own expense.

Day 2, Monday 15th June HELSINKI - LONGYEARBYEN & EMBARKATION

This morning we'll fly to Longyearbyen, Spitsbergen's largest settlement. Our bags will be transported directly to the ship, and we may have some free time to explore this quirky town before embarkation in the late afternoon. Get to know your fellow expeditioners and the friendly Quark Team of experts as we sail past the island's rugged, glacier-topped mountains rising majestically from frigid waters. *B/D*

Days 3 - 10, Tuesday 16th - Tuesday 23rd June ARCTIC CRUISE

Our expedition will cover western Spitsbergen and the stunning fjords to the north. From polar flora to immense glaciers, the natural landscape here is just as varied as the wildlife. Each expedition presents new opportunities and different weather and ice, so there is no fixed itinerary; the expert crew onboard will design the daily itinerary to optimise wildlife viewing with an appreciation of the history and geology of Spitsbergen. Places we may visit include the 14th of July Glacier, Smeerenburg, the towering cliffs of Alkefjellet, home to thousands of Brünnich's guillemots, and the Hinlopen Strait. On land, the tundra can be surprisingly colourful in summer, with wildflowers bursting for a taste of sunshine. Each day, you'll see something interesting: an ever-changing gallery of spectacular icebergs, or witnessing a walrus haul-out, or an abandoned historical site from centuries ago. This remote archipelago is one of the world's best places to spot polar bears against stunning natural backdrops of mountains and ice. Your expedition

team is as keen as you to find them and will be on constant watch to spot these inspiring creatures - at a safe distance!
All meals on board

On 23rd June, we disembark in Longyearbyen and fly back to Helsinki for another one-night stay near the airport. The charter flight to/from Longyearbyen and Helsinki is included, and flight schedules are to be advised.

Day 11, Wednesday 24th June DEPART HELSINKI
